(1) The number of legislative decisions for prohibited checks (open a check account of write a check) and the revoked of these decisions announced officially -either by letter or electronic environment- from the legislative authorities to the banks via The Banks Association of Turkey Risk Center.

(2) Due to the Law 6273, which was enforced on the date of February 3rd, 2012, the process of prohibited check decisions given to the drawers of the returned checks accelerated and cases waiting in the courts were concluded in short times. As a result, the number of legislative decisions for prohibited checks was increased significantly in March 2012, then normalized since 2013.

() The data until March 2017 was prepared by Central Bank of Turkey. Starting from April 2017, it was prepared by The Banks Association of Turkey Risk Center according to the 5th article of the Law No. 5941.*

(3) The total of the months is not equal to the row and column total of the table. The difference is due to the fact that "a person" can be counted more than once in different months, but "only once" in the row and column totals.
